Thank you for your interest in South Port Sailing Club. South Port is owned and operated on a volunteer basis by its members. Enclosed is an information package outlining membership privileges and responsibilities and application material.

Following is information on the fees, dues and dockage policies and fees.

Applying for Family Membership

To apply for membership, you will need to complete the following

- Application for Membership
- Membership Agreement

Your application will need to be proposed and seconded by two family members. Neither of these sponsors can be current Executive Board members.

Initiation Fees

Family Membership initiation fee is currently set at \$1500 plus 13% HST. The Membership Agreement sets out three options for payment of the initiation fee; we ask that you indicate your preference and enclose a cheque for the appropriate amount when returning the completed form. This cheque will be cashed only if your application is successful.

Annual Dues

Annual dues are billed each spring; Family membership is currently \$526.00 + 13% HST included is \$17.00 which covers our club's membership in the Canadian Yachting and Ontario Sailing Associations. For Applications after mid-season, a pro-rated reduction is applied to the initial year's dues.

Member's Work Hour Commitment

As all volunteer organizations require the support of its volunteer members, members are expected to provide ten (10) work hours to the Club each year as per the Membership Agreement. Any hours not contributed are billed in the following year, currently set at \$30.00 per hour.

Well Assignment Policy

We endeavour to ensure that all members who request a well at South Port Sailing Club are accommodated, but new members must appreciate that dockage is limited, particularly for larger boats, and that available SPSC slips are allocated on a seniority basis. All members must remember that minimum water levels in the harbour or the channel are not guaranteed. Once your application has been approved and you are interested in keeping a boat at South Port, application for a well should be made to the Harbour Master.

Dockage and Winter Storage Fees (current)

- Seasonal well fees; \$1.08 x LOA (feet) x max beam (feet) (i.e. 1.08 x 30' x 10' = \$324.00 + HST)
- Winter storage fees use the same formula
- Dry-sailed dinghies / inflatable tenders; \$58.00 per half season (+HST)
- Lasers (in rack storage): \$29.00 per half season (+HST)

Application Process

Following the receipt of your completed application, you will be asked to attend an informal interview at the club.

After the interview, your application is posted for the general membership via the club bulletin board for a period of ten (10) days.

At the next monthly meeting of the Executive, if no concerns have been raised, your application will be accepted and you will become a member of South Port Sailing Club

**South Port Sailing Club
Membership Agreement**

I agree to abide by and respect the constitution and by-laws of the South Prot Sailing Club (the Club) and otherwise remain a member in good standing for the duration of my membership;

I understand that South Port Sailing club endeavours to accommodate all members requesting a well assignment, but I also understand that dockage is limited, particularly for larger boats, and that available South Port Sailing Club slips are allocated on a seniority basis. South Port Sailing Club does not guarantee a minimum depth in the harbour, the creek or the channel in Lake St Clair.

I agree that as a condition of membership, I shall complete a minimum of ten (10) hours of annual unpaid service related to general clubhouse and grounds maintenance, the social program, race or cruise activities, to be completed by the end of the calendar year;

I understand that for each hour less than the minimum ten (10) hours, which is not completed, a levy of thirty dollars (\$30.00) will be applied and added to the membership renewal fee for the subsequent calendar year;

I agree to pay the annual membership fee and such other payments as required according to a financial need statement as conditions of general membership;

As a condition of membership approval, I agree to pay an initiation fee in installments according to Option A, B or C below.

Option A

Payment of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) plus 13% HST upon execution of this agreement \$1,695.00

Option B

Payment of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) plus 13% HST upon execution of this agreement \$ 565.00

Payment of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) plus 13% HST upon receipt of a letter of Membership confirmation \$ 565.00

Payment of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) plus 6% interest plus 13% HST on the date of membership Renewal in the next calendar year \$ 598.90

Total \$1,728.90

Option C

Payment of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) plus 13% HST upon execution of membership agreement \$ 452.00

Payment of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) plus 13% HST in the year following membership approval along with payment of annual membership fees \$ 452.00

Payment of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) plus 13% HST along with payment of annual membership fees \$ 452.00

Payment of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) plus 13% HST along with payment of annual membership fees \$ 452.00

Total \$1,808.00

I agree that if at any time, I decide not to renew my membership, prior to the acceptance of my resignation by the Executive, the initiation fee and all other monies owing to the Club shall be paid in full.
