- NO DROPPED RACES ALLOWED

ONE DESIGN – One Design racing is the purest of sailboat competition; it removes the boats ability entirely and places the results directly on top of the teams strengths and weaknesses.

Due to the known knowledge that the Sailing School 420's range in level's of competitiveness, teams signed up for a series, will follow weekly boat rotation criteria.

- All teams will have fair rotation of boats and sails.

Things can break, and breakdowns can also be avoided. **All sailors, for every week they sail must have their boat in its original sailing state, or better.** Extra running rigging is available to maintain fleet.
