Gary Gavin August 2, 1946 - August 16, 2018



On August 16th member Gary Gavin passed away at the age of 72. Gary started sailing as he always described it 'way back when' on a wood and fibreglass homemade built San Francisco Pelican, which led to the purchase of a Shark. He learned to sail on a Mirage 24, and spent 18 years crewing and cruising on Harold Asseltine's Kirby 30. He also spent a year crewing on a 46 footer out of Detroit Boat Club, and in 2007 started cruising for 5-7 weeks each year with Bill Asseltine (Harold's son) on a Voyager 38' Catamaran in Granada.

After retiring from a 32 year career, as an educator with the Board of Education, he took up Scuba Diving and bought into a store. Gary started crewing for Frank Edgley in mid 2000 on Bulldog, and eventually purchased a Viking 28, 'Rocket' renamed 'Raider' and rejoined South Port in 2013.

Even after suffering a spinal stroke 2 years ago, Gary continued to sail as often as he could on is beloved Raider with the assistance of member Matt Draisey who maintained his boat for him. His last sail was at the Monday night race on August 13th. Gary was an enthusiastic member, and had a positive outlook on life regardless of the circumstances.
