

1 RULES

The event will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 1745 on the day it will take effect.

3 MONDAY DATES

• 20 races May 15th through Sept. 25th

4 STARTING TIMES

The warning signal will be at 1845.


5 COMMUNICATIONS & PROTEST FLAGS

The RC will broadcast on VHF channel 69.

RRS 61.1(a) is changed so that *first reasonable opportunity* to conspicuously display a red flag is defined as being within one minute. Radio notification on VHF 69 is also recommended.

6 PERMANENT MARKS

The octagon of permanent course marks is centred at 42°20.406′N 82°50.231′W — course marks are white can buoys The start and finish line will be located at mark 4.



Marks are 0.75 nautical miles from the centre.

All bearings are magnetic.





Every third mark around the circle. Overall course length is 11.1 nautical miles.



#4 & #5 ZIG-ZAG






8 THE START & FINISH

The starting line is between the orange flag on the race committee boat and mark 4.

The finishing line is between the blue flag on the race committee boat and mark 4.

9 STARTING RACES

Races shall be started by using the following signals. Times shall be taken from light tower signals; the absence of a sound signal shall be disregarded.

This replaces rule RRS 26 and RRS Race Signals Preparatory Signals.

10 TIME LIMITS

The race time limit is two hours.

Boats failing to finish within one hour after the first boat starts, sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish without a hearing. This changes rules RRS 35 and RRS A5.1.

11 HEARING REQUESTS

The protest time limit is one hour after the race committee boat docks.

Notices of hearings will be posted no later than one hour after the protest time limit.
