As requested last year, you are required to provide a copy of your boat insurance, or an Insurance rider if your boat insurance is part of your homeowners policy. The form you provide should indicate the liability amount and expiration date. Uninsured boats will not be launched.

**Pease refer to the Harbourmasters email of February 19th.** Completion of form & on line submission with a copy of your Insurance coverage is available.

For those using e-transfer, please send the treasurer an email with the answer to your security question.

**All club members** who are planning to keep their boat at the club, either in wet mooring, dry sailing or dinghy sailing must fill out and submit the form.  
Please return the form to the Harbourmaster by April 1, 2022 to allow the committee to work out well assignments. If yours is not received on time your former well or dry sailing space may be assigned to someone else. There will be an administration fee of \$100.00 for late submission.
